- ONT Connection:** Fiber optic cables do not connect directly to standard routers. The fiber line terminates at an ONT, which converts the optical signal to Ethernet. Connect the ONT's Ethernet output to your router's WAN port to establish internet access.
- Router Configuration:** Ensure the router's WAN port is set to auto-negotiate or manually configured for 100Mbps if needed. Some routers may default to 100Mbps due to firmware or port settings, which can limit performance if misconfigured.
- Enabling Quality of Service (QoS)** can help prioritize traffic for streaming or VoIP services.
- Troubleshooting Speed Issues:** If your gigabit router shows only 100Mbps, check the following:
 - Ethernet cable quality and type (Cat5e or higher recommended)
 - Router port settings and firmware updates
 - ONT output speed and compatibility
 - Device network adapters and drivers
