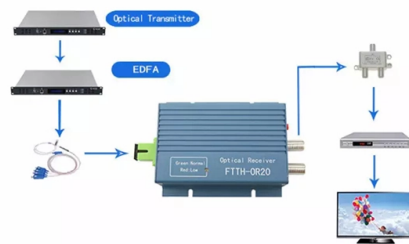

Key Differences Between PoE and Standard Switches

Standard Ethernet Switch	PoE Switch
Connects multiple devices within a LAN for data transmission only.	Combines data transmission with electrical power delivery over the same Ethernet cable.
Requires separate power sources for devices like IP cameras or phones.	Eliminates the need for separate power adapters or outlets near devices.
Generally less expensive and simpler for data-only networks.	Simplifies installation, reduces cabling, and allows flexible device placement.
Available in unmanaged (plug-and-play) and managed versions for network control.	Supports centralized power management, enabling remote rebooting and monitoring of connected devices.

PoE Standards: PoE, PoE+, and PoE++

Standard	Max Power per Port	Typical Devices	Notes
PoE (802.3af)	15.4W (12.95W to device)	VoIP phones, stationary cameras, sensors	Suitable for low-power devices
PoE+ (802.3at)	30W (25.5W to device)	PTZ cameras, IP phones, alarm systems	Supports moderate-power devices; backward compatible with PoE
PoE++ (802.3bt)	Type 3: 60W, Type 4: 100W	High-power cameras, digital signage, large wireless APs	Uses all four cable pairs for higher power; ideal for future-proof networks
