Switchgear wiring in Belize involves proper installation of LT and HV components, adherence to BEL standards, and compliance with PUC-approved electrical designs. Switchgear Components Belize switchgear systems include Low Tension (LT) and High Voltage (HV) components. Key LT components are: Switch Fuse Unit (SFU): Combines a manual switch and fuse for circuit isolation and protection during maintenance. Compact and easy to operate, it reduces the number of joints in a circuit. Miniature Circuit Breaker (MCB): Automatically disconnects circuits during overloads, providing fast protection. Moulded Case Circuit Breaker (MCCB): Protects against overloads and short circuits in higher current applications. Earth Leakage Circuit Breaker (ELCB): Detects leakage currents to prevent electric shocks, enhancing safety. High Voltage (HV) switchgear includes Current Transformers (CTs) and Potential Transformers (PTs) for metering and protection before voltage transformation, while Low Voltage (LV) systems operate after transformation, typically at 120/208 V or 120/240 V depending on the service type. Wiring Types and Practices Belize switchgear wiring uses various insulated wires based on application: V.I.R. (Vulcanized India Rubber) wires for flexibility and insulation. C.T.S. (Cross-Linked Thermosetting) wires for higher temperature tolerance. P.V.C. insulated wires for general-purpose wiring. Proper earthing is essential to prevent electric shocks, connecting the system to the ground. Wiring must follow PUC-approved installation standards, ensuring safety and regulatory compliance. Service Connections BEL provides single-phase and three-phase services: Single-phase, 3-wire, 120/240 V for residential customers. Three-phase, 4-wire, 120/208 V for commercial or industrial applications. The service drop connects BEL's secondary conductors to the customer's weather heads, and the service point marks the termination of supply conductors to the customer's system.
