These frames, often made of galvanized steel, can store significant lengths of cable (e.g., up to 80 meters of 10mm cable) and are suitable for installation on poles or inside manholes. Routing and Fixing Units FDBs include cable fixing units, removable entrances, and optional drop cable exits to organize incoming and outgoing fibers. These features help maintain mechanical protection, proper bend radius, and easy access for future connections. Planning for Future Expansion When reserving cable, it is recommended to leave 20-30% headroom beyond current needs. This allows for additional fiber connections or network upgrades without replacing the entire distribution box.
