Installation and Safety Before working in a junction box, turn off the circuit breaker and verify zero voltage using a voltage tester. Essential tools include wire strippers, lineman's pliers, twist-on wire connectors (wire nuts), and personal protective equipment like insulated gloves and safety glasses . Conductors should be stripped to the correct length (typically 1/2 to 5/8 inch), clean, straight, and free of nicks to ensure a secure splice. Wires of the same gauge should be used together to maintain a reliable connection . Code Requirements Accessibility: Junction boxes must remain permanently accessible; they cannot be covered by drywall or other finishes . Box Fill: The number of conductors in a box must comply with NEC 314.16 to prevent overcrowding and overheating . Protection: Cables must be secured and protected according to NEC 314.17 and 300.4 . When Required: NEC 300.15 mandates a junction box whenever splices, terminations, or pull points occur, unless specific exceptions apply, such as certain temporary wiring or Class 2/3 circuits . Splicing Methods The most common method is a pigtail connection using a twist-on wire connector. This ensures low resistance, minimizes heat generation, and preserves the full current capacity of the conductors . All splices should be mechanically secure and properly insulated. Practical Tips Use the correct size of junction box for the number of conductors. Ensure all splices are fully inside the box...
