- Grounding and Bonding:** Metallic trays must be properly grounded and bonded to ensure safety.
- Supports:** Cables must be securely fastened, and vertical or horizontal installations follow the same fill requirements.
- Covers:** Optional but recommended in high-traffic areas or outdoor installations to protect cables from physical damage or sunlight.
