In such cases, the fiber cable can be plugged into the router's SFP port, but this is less common in typical home setups.

Avoid bending or damaging fiber cables, as they are fragile.

Ensure the router is turned off before connecting fiber to prevent technical issues.

Keep connectors clean and aligned properly to maintain signal quality.
