Cable tray supports are specified based on span, load capacity, material, mounting type, and compliance with standards like IEC 61537 to ensure safe and durable cable management.

Support Spacing Support spacing depends on the type of cable tray and the load it carries:

- Short Span Trays:** Typically supported every 6–8 feet for indoor, non-industrial installations.
- Intermediate Span Trays:** Supported every 10–12 feet, suitable for moderate loads.
- Long Span Trays:** Supported every 14–20 feet, often used outdoors or for heavy cable loads.
- Extra-Long Span Trays:** Exceeding 20 feet, used for road crossings or to minimize expensive supports.

Support spacing directly affects tray strength and must be coordinated with splice plate locations.

Load Capacity Cable tray supports must accommodate:

- Cable weight:** Including all installed cables.
- Environmental loads:** Wind, snow, ice, or seismic forces.

Load testing is recommended to validate tray strength according to IEC 61537.

Materials and Corrosion Protection Common materials: Steel, stainless steel, aluminum.

Surface treatments: Galvanization, powder coating, or anodizing to resist corrosion, especially in marine, coastal, or chemical environments.

Material selection depends on mechanical strength, environmental exposure, and electrical continuity requirements.

Mounting Methods Cable trays can be mounted using:

- Wall brackets:** For vertical or horizontal runs along walls.
- Suspended supports:** Rods or hangers from ceilings.
- Center suspensions:** For long spans or heavy loads.
- Mounting plates:** For junction boxes or equipment supports.

Accessories and Compliance Fittings: Horizontal/vertical bends, T-pieces, crossovers, reductions, and end closures.

Covers and protection rings: For EMI/RFI shielding or moisture protection.

Bushings: Protect cable jackets where cables exit tray bottoms.

Compliance with IEC 61537 ensures mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, electrical continuity, and proper installation practices.
