Trays can be multi-layered to accommodate varying numbers of fibers and allow easy access for maintenance or future expansion .

Fiber Placement and Storage DevicesThe fiber placement device or storage tray stores excess fiber and connectors in an orderly manner. It ensures that leftover fiber lengths are sufficient (typically at least 1 meter) and that winding diameters meet minimum standards (e.g., 35 mm) to avoid microbends or stress on the fibers . Proper storage prevents damage from environmental conditions and facilitates efficient network management.
