The government of the Democratic Republic of the Congo has signed a contract with China's Gosuncn Technology Group to build a fiber optic line approximately 2,100 kilometers long along the Congo River, with a contract value of \$1.5 billion fiber-optic network along the Congo. BCS Group has completed its 400km-long Lake Tanganyika Submarine Cable Project, which is the deepest inland undersea fiber optic cable in the world. The Central African Backbone (CAB) is a fiber-optic Internet backbone connecting the countries of the Economic Community of Central African States (ECCAS) in Africa via high speed internet. —The route: Roughly 2,100 km of infrastructure: about 1,700 km of cable following the river from Muanda on the Atlantic to Kisangani, plus some.
