

Connecting the 24 optical ports of the switch

To connect the 24 optical ports of an access switch, use compatible SFP transceivers, LC fiber cables, and follow proper port pairing and configuration procedures.

Step 1: Identify Compatible SFP Modules Each optical port on your switch requires an SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) transceiver. Ensure the transceiver matches the distance and fiber type of your network.

Multi-mode fiber is typically used for short distances (up to 550 meters), while single-mode fiber supports longer distances (up to several kilometers). Ensure the fiber cables are clean and free of dust to prevent signal loss.

Step 3: Insert SFP Modules Power off the switch before inserting SFP modules if recommended by the manufacturer. Insert each SFP module into the optical port until it clicks securely. Avoid forcing the module to prevent damage.

Step 4: Connect Fiber Cables Connect one end of the LC fiber cable to the SFP module on the switch. Connect the other end to the corresponding SFP port on the peer device (another switch, router, or media converter). Ensure correct transmit (TX) and receive (RX) orientation; most SFP modules are duplex, so TX on one end connects to RX on the other.

Step 5: Configure the Switch Access the switch management interface via web GUI or CLI. Verify that each optical port is recognized and operational. Enable or configure PoE settings if the switch supports powering devices over Ethernet. For hybrid switches with paired SFP and RJ-45 ports, only one of the paired ports can be active at a time.

Step 6: Test Connectivity Use the switch interface to check link status and speed for each optical port. Optionally, run traffic tests to ensure proper data tr...
