Trenching and Conduit Installation For underground installations, trenches are typically dug 1-1.2 meters (3-4 feet) deep, with deeper burial in cold climates to avoid frost damage. Trenching methods vary based on site conditions: conventional trenching for open areas, narrow trenching, or horizontal directional drilling (HDD) in urban or high-traffic zones to minimize surface disruption. Conduits (HDPE or PVC) protect the fiber from moisture, mechanical stress, and future excavation. Pre-installed innerducts with pulling tapes facilitate cable installation, and conductive marker tape is often buried above the conduit to aid future location and prevent accidental damage. Proper burial depth and conduit selection are critical for long-term durability. Cable Laying Techniques Fiber optic cables are delicate and require careful handling. For shorter distances, cable pulling machines are used, while cable blowing with compressed air is preferred for longer runs to reduce strain. Maintaining the minimum bend radius and avoiding excessive pulling tension prevents fiber breakage. Armored or reinforced cables may be used in high-risk areas. Splicing and Termination Fiber segments are joined using fusion splicing, which welds fibers together for minimal signal loss, or mechanical splicing, which aligns fibers mechanically.
