Industrial boards typically require a mounting area with a maximum width of 1.5 meters, height of 1.2 meters, and depth of 0.5 meters, often with an IP54 protection rating.

Safety and Protection Requirements

Electrical Protection: Circuits must be protected against overcurrent, short circuits, and earth faults using appropriate fuses or circuit breakers.

Shock and Thermal Protection: Compliance with DIN VDE 0100 series or equivalent IEC standards ensures protection against electric shock and thermal effects.

Grounding and Earthing: Proper earthing is mandatory to protect both people and equipment from electrical faults.

Voltage and Current Ratings: Distribution boxes must match the expected load to prevent overheating and equipment failure.

Design and Layout Considerations

Component Arrangement: Breakers, busbars, terminals, and protective devices should be arranged ergonomically for clarity and maintenance ease.

Space for Expansion: Plan for 20-30% extra space to accommodate future circuits or upgrades.
