

Does PoE power supply require an optical module



Overview

Although SFP modules themselves do not support PoE, they can be used in conjunction with a PoE-capable switch or injector to provide data and power to devices that require power supply. Power over Ethernet (PoE) describes any of several standards or ad hoc systems that pass electric power along with data on twisted-pair Ethernet cabling. This allows a single cable to provide both a data connection and enough electricity to power networked devices such as wireless access points. SFP modules are small pluggable optical modules commonly used for fiber optic transmission in network equipment, while PoE is a technology that allows power and data to be transmitted over Ethernet cables. So, does the SFP module support PoE?

Let's explore it. While PoE doesn't add Ethernet data capabilities, it does offer expanded options for how and where Ethernet end devices can be. POE allows an Ethernet cable to carry DC power as well as data signals to attached devices. Ethernet cable (CAT 5,6 &7) uses 4 twisted pairs. All in all, this should be required reading for anyone who works with Ethernet, because it's one of those things too often presented as something of a black box.
