

Electrical Distribution Box Grounding Wire Connection Diagram

A distribution box connects the main power supply to individual circuits, with all metal parts and neutral properly grounded via a PE bar or grounding electrode. Components and Layout A typical distribution box includes: Main MCB (Double-Pole): Connects the incoming phase and neutral supply. RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker): Provides protection against leakage currents and electric shocks. Single-Pole MCBs: Protect individual circuits or appliances. Neutral Bar: Distributes neutral connections to all output circuits. PE (Protective Earth) Bar / Grounding Bar: Central point for all grounding connections. Wiring Connections Incoming Supply: Connect the phase (live) wire to the input of the main MCB. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bar. Connect the ground wire from the power supply to the PE bar using a yellow-green insulated copper wire of appropriate cross-section (typically $\geq 6 \text{ mm}^2$ internationally, 10 AWG in the US). MCB to RCCB: Output of the main MCB connects to the input of the RCCB. Output of the RCCB connects to the individual MCBs for each circuit. Circuit Connections: Each single-pole MCB output connects to the respective load. Neutral wires from loads connect to the neutral bar. Ground wires from loads connect to the PE bar. Grounding of Components: Any metallic parts inside the distribution box, such as mounting plates or enclosures, must be connected to the PE bar. If a grounding electrode (ground rod or copper water pipe) is used, connect it to the PE bar to ensure a low-resistance path to earth (
