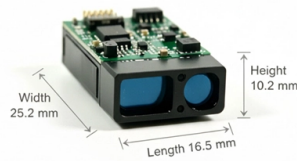

- Ingress Protection (IP) Rating:** Higher IP ratings protect against dust and water, essential for outdoor or high-humidity environments ().
- Fiber Management Features:** Ensure the box includes fusion splice trays, SC/LC adapters, bend-radius protection, and organized cable guides to maintain signal quality ().
