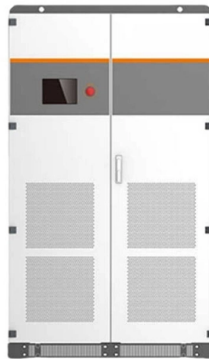


Fiber Optic Patch Cord Usage Tutorial

Routing and Bend Radius Route the patch cord carefully, avoiding sharp bends. Adhere to the minimum bend radius specified for the fiber type to prevent stress and attenuation. Use cable guides or raceways for organized routing.

Connector Mating Insert connectors carefully into the corresponding ports. Do not cross-mate incompatible connectors (e.g., SC/APC with SC/UPC) as this can damage the endfaces and degrade performance.

Labeling and Documentation Properly label each patch cord and document connections to ensure traceability and simplify future troubleshooting or network upgrades.

Testing Use a visual fault locator (VFL) or optical power meter to verify connectivity and detect any breaks or faults in the fiber.
