

# Fiber Optic Splitter High-Speed Network Equipment

- Planar Lightwave Circuit (PLC) Splitters** Fabricated using photolithography on silica glass, PLC splitters provide compact size, uniform splitting ratios, and broad wavelength coverage ( $\pm 200$  nm). Ideal for high fiber counts (1x4, 1x8, 1x16, 1x32) and rack-mounted or LGX module deployments.
- Advantages:** low cost, high reliability, low polarization-dependent loss (PDL), and low insertion loss (IL).
- Limitations:** lower power handling compared to fusion couplers.
- Fused Biconical Taper (FBT) Splitters** Made by twisting and fusing fibers together, FBT splitters offer low insertion loss ( $\sim 0.3$  dB) and high power handling. Best for small fiber counts and applications requiring minimal loss.
- Limitations:** narrower wavelength bandwidth ( $\pm 40$  nm) and lower polarization extinction ratio.
- Fusion Couplers** Similar to FBT but optimized for high power and low IL, suitable for single-mode, multimode, and double-clad fibers. Operate across 300–2000 nm and temperatures up to 300°C.
- Micro-Optic Couplers** Use lensed fiber collimators with an optical element in between. Provide ultra-broad bandwidth ( $\pm 200$  nm), high polarization extinction ratio ( $> 30$  dB), and excellent thermal stability. Allow integration of filters and polarizers but are more expensive.
