Fiber optic cables are categorized into: Singlemode (OS1, OS2): Small core ($\sim 9 \mu\text{m}$) for long-distance, high-speed transmission, suitable for outdoor, campus, or telecom networks. Multimode (OM1-OM5): Larger cores ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) for short-distance applications like data centers or LANs, with OM3/OM4 supporting 10G-100G Ethernet over hundreds of meters. Fiber optic cables are ideal when high-speed, low-latency, and long-distanc...
