Standard Fiber Jacket Colors

Individual Fiber Identification

Within a cable, individual fibers are color-coded according to the TIA-598-C standard, which uses a 12-color sequence for identification: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown, Slate, White, Red, Black, Yellow, Violet, Rose, Aqua. For cables with more than 12 fibers, the sequence repeats with stripes to maintain unique identification. This system ensures technicians can quickly identify and splice fibers correctly, regardless of the cable type or fiber count.

Multimode fiber: Orange (OM1/OM2) or aqua (OM3/OM4) jacket, beige/aqua connectors, wider core for short-distance LED or laser-optimized transmission.
