

Fixing of cable trays inside vertical shafts

- Mechanical Stress:** Avoid over-tightening ties or clamps, which can damage insulation or conductors. Use mounting brackets, clamps, or cleats that provide consistent lateral clamping force.
- Thermal and Load Cycling:** Account for cable expansion and contraction due to temperature changes or load cycling to prevent slippage, elongation, or insulation cracking.
- High Tensile Strength:** For heavy or high-voltage cables, consider using steel wire armor or integrated pulling members to increase tensile strength and prevent slippage.
- Safety Precautions:** Vertical shaft installations are inherently dangerous. Ensure proper planning, risk assessment, and use of personal protective equipment. Only trained personnel should perform the installati...
