

Flip-type cold splice connection method



Overview

Steps to Perform a Cold Splice: Prepare the fiber optic cables by stripping the outer jacket and cleaning the bare fiber. Unlike fusion splicing, which uses heat to join two optical fibers together, cold connection uses mechanical means to create a stable and low-loss connection. Either joining method must have three primary characteristics. The steps of optical fiber cold splicing are as follows: ① First install the cold connector, buckle the snap rings on both sides, and snap down the middle slot; ② Strip the fiber, strip about 3CM long, and wipe it with alcohol; ③ Put in the cutting knife and cut about 1. Either termination method must have two primary.
