

Full process of cable tray bend

Materials and Tools Required

- Forming the Bend** Use a manual bender or press brake to gradually bend each segment. Ensure uniform bending to maintain the tray's integrity and proper cable support. For flat bends, flatten the tray lip at the bend point using a blunt object before bending.
- Rejoining and Reinforcing** After bending, rejoin the cut sections using welding or bolting/riveting with metal strips for reinforcement. For flat 90° bends, measure the internal edge distance and fabricate a gusset to bolt onto the bend, completing the structural support.
- Final Checks** Ensure the bend maintains the minimum bend radius required for the cables, avoids sharp edges, and provides continuous support along the tray. Verify alignment and structural stability before installation.

Additional Considerations

- Bend Radius:** Maintain a radius that prevents cable damage and allows easy cable pulling.
- Material Selection:** Use galvanized or stainless steel for industrial applications to ensure durability and...
