Installation Considerations

Load Capacity and Spacing: Maximum load per hanger ranges from 318 kg (700 lbs) to 340 kg (750 lbs), with recommended support spacing up to 3.6 meters for standard horizontal trays.

Materials: Hangers are typically made from pre-galvanized steel, hot-dipped galvanized steel, or stainless steel (A316/A4) to ensure durability and corrosion resistance.

Expansion Joints: For horizontal trays, combined expansion joints are often included to accommodate thermal expansion and prevent stress on the tray system.

Crossbeam Installation: For larger trays, crossbeam setups with two hangers per crossarm provide additional stability and load distribution.

Seismic Bracing: In earthquake-prone areas, seismic bracing can be added to limit displacement and vibration, ensuring the tray remains secure.

Best Practices Ensure hangers are installed by qualified personnel following a pre-determined layout plan to maintain proper alignment and load distribution. Use hangers and brackets that are compatible with the specific cable tray system to ma...
