Proximity to Power Supply: Position the box close to the main power supply to minimize wiring complexity and reduce voltage drop. Ensure the box has sufficient capacity to accommodate current wiring and allow for future expansion.

Indoor vs. Outdoor Placement: Indoor locations such as garages, basements, or dedicated utility rooms are ideal. If installed outdoors, ensure compliance with IP/NEMA ratings for waterproofing and durability.

Labeling and Organization: Clearly label all circuits and maintain organized wiring inside the box. This facilitates troubleshooting, inspection, and future upgrades.
