- Surge Protection Device (SPD):** Protects sensitive electronics from voltage spikes and lightning surges.

- Room Socket Circuits:** Assign separate circuits for each room to isolate faults and prevent total power loss.
- High-Power Appliance Circuits:** Appliances like ovens, air conditioners, and water heaters should have dedicated circuits to prevent overloading.
