

How to connect a network cable to the router in the fiber optic box

Take the Ethernet cable and plug one end into the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port. Plug the other end into your router's WAN/Internet port, which is often labeled and colored differently from LAN ports. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 4: Optimize Placement and Settings

Place both the ONT and router near electrical outlets and in a dry, ventilated area. For best performance, use a high-quality Ethernet cable and ensure the router supports gigabit speeds to fully leverage fiber internet. Access the router's configuration interface (usually via 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to verify settings and enable features like Quality of Service (QoS) if needed.

Step 5: Verify Connection

Check the ONT lights: Power should be solid green, and the data/Internet light should indicate active communication. Test internet connectivity on a device connected to the router via Wi-Fi or Ethernet. By f...
