They are designed for FTTR (Fiber to the Room) setups, providing dedicated high-speed fiber connections to each room without disrupting interior aesthetics.

Installation Methods

Adhesive-Backed Mounting Many invisible fiber systems, such as Corning Clear Track, use a proprietary adhesive backing that allows the cable to be pressed directly onto surfaces like walls, ceilings, or baseboards. The adhesive is strong enough to hold the cable in place permanently without additional staples, glues, or conduits, enabling fast, non-destructive installation.

Clip-Based or Micro-Channel Deployment Some systems, like the LongXing transparent fiber system, use transparent clips or micro-channels to secure ultra-thin fibers along baseboards, window frames, or trim. These clips are designed to be unobtrusive, keeping the cable nearly invisible while maintaining high broadband speeds.

Peel-and-Stick Pathways Clear Track and similar solutions offer micro-replicated channels that scatter light, making the pathway almost invisible. Installers simply peel back a protective liner and press the channel onto the surface. This method supports single or multiple fibers, including 900 μm fibers or micromo...
