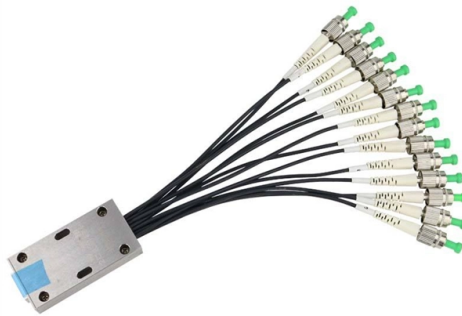


How to connect the fiber optic cables to the four junction boxes
