

How to connect the terminal box to the rack

Always verify that the wire gauge matches the terminal block specifications.

Step 4: Connect the Wires Insert the stripped wire ends into the terminal block openings. Depending on the terminal block type:

- Screw terminals:** Tighten the screw using a torque screwdriver to secure the wire.
- Push-in or spring-clamp terminals:** Simply push the wire into the clamp; the spring mechanism will hold it securely. For fine-stranded wires, open the clamp with the operating tool before insertion. Check each connection by gently tugging on the wire to ensure it is firmly seated.

Step 5: Organize and Label Use marking strips or labels to identify each terminal and wire. This improves maintenance, troubleshooting...
