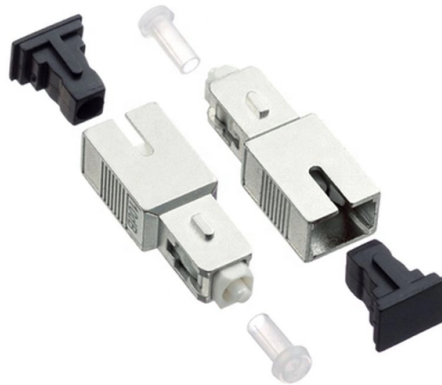


How to control the switch in a lighting distribution box

Lighting distribution box switches should be configured according to circuit load, safety requirements, and intended control, typically using a main breaker, leakage switch, and individual single-pole breakers for each lighting circuit.

Key Components and Switch Types

- Main Power Switch / Main Breaker** Controls the entire electrical supply to the distribution box. Typically rated for the maximum current capacity of the system. Allows complete disconnection during maintenance or emergencies.
- Leakage / Residual Current Device (RCD)** Provides protection against electric shock and leakage currents. Often a DZ47LE-63-C60 type is used for safety in residential and commercial lighting. Positioned immediately after the main switch to protect downstream circuits.
- Single-Pole Circuit Breakers** Control individual lighting circuits (e.g., kitchen, living room, office areas). Rated according to the expected load, commonly 16–20A for lighting circuits. Live wires are connected to the upper terminals (input) of the breakers, with neutral and ground properly terminated.

Wiring and Configuration Guidelines

- Incoming Power:** Connect the live, neutral, and ground wires from the main supply to the main breaker and bus bars.
- Outgoing Circuits:** Each single-pole breaker receives the live wire from the main breaker; neutral and ground are connected to their respective bus bars.
- Voltage Matching:** Ensure the branch circuit voltage matches the lighting equipment (typically 220V/380V).
- Wire Sizing:** Use copper conductors with cross-sectional area appropriate for the load, usually $\geq 4\text{mm}^2$ for lighting circuits.
- Environmental Considerations:** Ensure the distribution box and cabling can withstand temperature, humidity, and other environmental stresses.

 - Manual Switches:** Standard on/off switches can control individual circuits.
