Required tools include a fusion splicer, fiber cleaver, fiber stripper, and cleaning supplies. Proper preparation, such as cleaning and precise cleaving, is critical to ensure a high-quality splice.
- 2. Mechanical Splicing**
Mechanical splicing is an alternative method where the fibers are aligned and held together using a precision mechanical fixture:
 - The bare fiber of the pigtail is inserted into a mechanical splice holder.
 - Index-matching gel or adhesive is applied to reduce signal loss.
 - The splice is secured in a protective enclosure.Mechanical splicing is faster and requires less specialized equipment than fusion splicing, but it generally has slightly higher insertion loss and is more sensitive to environmental conditions.
- 3. Using Patch Cord Conversion**
In some cases, installers cut a pre-terminated patch cord into two pigtails. This method allows testing the patch cord first, then splitting it to create two pigtails for field splicing. This approach is practical when testing individual pigtail...
