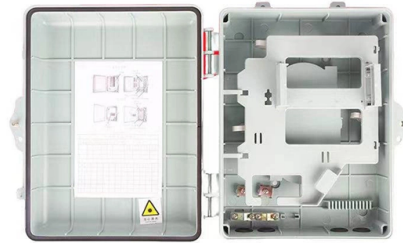


How to handle adding cable trays
