Attach the Clamp to the Pole: Use the stainless steel bands or wire bail to secure the clamp to the pole bracket or hook. Make sure it is tight enough to prevent movement but not so tight as to deform the clamp. Insert the ADSS Cable: Feed the cable through the clamp, ensuring it rests in the protective inlay or groove. The clamp should allow the cable to slip slightly under tension to prevent stress concentration (). Secure the Cable: If the clamp has a wedge or fiber grip, engage it to hold the cable firmly at tension points. Check that the cable is not twisted or ben...
