

How to make a suspended vertical cable tray

Check alignment and spacing after each section to maintain a straight vertical run and proper cable separation.

Safety and Best Practices Avoid using the tray as a lifting point or walkway. Consider heat dissipation: vertical stacking can increase cable temperature, so de-rating may be necessary. Use UL-listed or manufacturer-approved vertical tray systems if available, as simply rotating a horizontal tray on its side may compromise structural integrity. Always fo...
