

How to plug the SCP fiber optic interface into the router

- Verify the Connection:** Check the router's status lights or run a speed test to confirm that the fiber connection is active and stable.

- Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply; maintain gentle curves to prevent signal loss.
- Keep the SC connector clean; dust or dirt can degrade performance.
