

How to seal a round junction box

For outdoor boxes, leave the bottom edge slightly unsealed to allow drainage of any condensation.
- 4. Use Waterproof Connectors** Replace standard wire connectors with gel-filled or heat-shrink waterproof connectors. These prevent moisture from wicking into the box through the wire connections.
- 5. Install a Weatherproof Cover** Choose a cover specifically designed for your junction box size and type. Ensure it fits snugly and is securely fastened. A weatherproof cover protects against rain, snow, and other environmental factors.
- 6. Optional: Epoxy Resin for Full Encapsulation** For extreme moisture protection, you can pour epoxy resin into the box to fully encapsulate the connections. This creates a strong, permanent barrier but is less flexible for future modifications.
- 7. Check for Proper Drainage and Ventilation** If the box is outdoors, consider creating a drip loop in the wires so water drips off before reaching the box. Ensure the box is mounted in a way that prevents water pooling.
