

How to stretch fiber optic cables

For example, modern bend-insensitive fibers may allow a radius as small as 4.4 mm, while older fibers require 30 mm or more. Avoid sharp turns, 90-degree angles, or squeezing multiple cables into narrow conduits. Use Lubricants and Proper Techniques For long conduit runs, use compatible fiber optic lubricants to reduce friction and prevent jacket damage. Always pull, don't push, and roll the cable off the spool rather than spinning it from the end to avoid twisting. When laying loops on a surface, use figure-8 loops to prevent twists and mechanical stress. Monitor and Communicate During Installation For long installations, have a minimum crew of three: one monitoring the pulling equipment, one monitoring the supply reel, and one coordinating along the path.
