

How to use a gigabit fiber optic router

- Power On the Router:** Wait for the router's indicator lights to confirm it is online.
- Access Router Settings:** Open a web browser and enter the router's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1) to log into the admin panel.
- Configure Internet Settings:** Input ISP-provided credentials, configure VLAN, DHCP, or PPPoE settings if required, and update firmware for optimal performance.
- Set Up Wi-Fi:** Choose a strong network name (SSID) and password, enable Wi-Fi 6 features, and configure Quality of Service (QoS) if needed for gaming or video calls.

Optimization Tips

- Router Placement:** Position the router centrally in your home, away from obstructions, for maximum coverage.
- Use Wired Connections for High-Speed Devices:** For devices requiring full gigabit speeds, connect via Ethernet rather than Wi-Fi.
- Monitor Speeds:** Test your connection using speed test tools to ensure you are achieving near-gigabit performance.
- Security:** Enable WPA3 encryption if supported.
