

How to use the PoE port of a switch

5. **Verify Connectivity and Power:** Check the indicator LEDs on the switch and the connected device to confirm both data transmission and power delivery. Use monitoring tools if available to track power consumption and ensure the switch's power budget is not exceeded.

- Distribute Power Evenly:** Avoid connecting too many high-power devices to a single switch if it exceeds the PoE budget.
- Use Proper Port Labeling:** Clearly label PoE ports to prevent accidental connection of non-PoE devices that may not require power.
- Monitor Network Performance:** Ensure IP addresses are correctly assigned to avoid conflicts and maintain smooth communication between devices.
- Follow Safety Guidelines:** Always use certified cables and avoid overloading the switch to prevent...
