

How to use the rack-mounted fiber optic tray

Installation and Mounting

Route Fiber Properly: Guide fibers through grommets and cable management channels, maintaining proper bend radius to avoid signal loss. Leave enough slack for full tray extension without tension.

Separate Incoming and Outgoing Cables: This prevents tangling and simplifies future tracing or maintenance.

Use Routing Guides and Tie-Downs: Integrated guides and tie points help maintain neat bundles and prevent stress on connectors.

Label Cables: Apply durable labels near connectors for easy identification and maintain up-to-date documentation for all connections.

Maintenance Tips

Access Without Disruption: Sliding or hinged trays allow servicing of connections without removing the entire enclosure from the rack.

Avoid Overcrowding: Maintain adequate spacing to prevent connector stress and ensure airflow if the enclosure is in a high-density environment...
