

How to wire a household plug and distribution box

Wiring a Household Plug

- Turn off the power at the main switch before starting.
- Identify the wires:
 - Live (Phase): Brown or black

 - Single-pole MCBs for individual circuits
 - RCCB/RCD for earth leakage protection
 - Neutral and earth bus bars
- Connect the incoming supply:
 - Live wire to the main MCB input
 - Neutral wire to the neutral bus bar
 - Earth wire to the earth bus bar
- Connect outgoing circuits:
 - Each circuit's live wire to its respective MCB output
 - Neutral wire to the neutral bus bar
 - Earth wire to the earth bus bar
- Install protective devices: Ensure the RCCB rating matches the main MCB and provides protection against leakage currents.
- Check wiring color codes according to your region (e.g., US: black/red for live, white for neutral, green for earth; UK/EU: brown for live, blue for neutral, green/yellow for earth).
- Label each circuit for easy identification.
- Test the system: After wiring, switch on the main supply and test each circuit for proper operation and safety.

Safety Tips

- Always turn off the main power before starting any wiring work.
- Use insulated tools and wear protective gloves.
- Ensure all connections are tight and no b...
