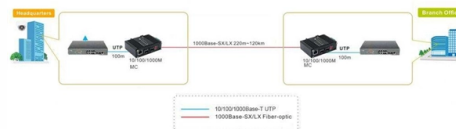


Illustration of concealed wiring method for distribution box
