

Independent cable tray installation

Tray sizing must accommodate the number and type of cables, preventing overcrowding and overheating.

Support and Mounting Independent trays require robust support systems: Use wall brackets, ceiling trapeze hangers, or floor supports depending on the installation location. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters, adjusted for tray type and load. Ensure supports can handle current and future cable loads, including any additional equipment. Avoid cutting or drilling structural members without approval from the general contractor.

Installation Practices Align trays straight and level, connecting sections with approved fittings and splice plates, avoiding mid-gap placement. Maintain the minimum bending radius for cables when using elbows or accessories. Ground and bond trays according to NEC Article 392 or local electrical codes to ensure electrical continuity every 18 meters. Inspect all trays, accessories, and grounding connections for damage before installation.
