

Installation of cable trays under the wall

Selecting the Tray and Supports Choose the appropriate tray type based on cable size and environment: Ladder trays: Ideal for power cables, provide ventilation and easy cable entry. Ventilated trough trays: Better for smaller control or instrumentation cables to prevent sagging. Materials: Steel, aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) depending on moisture, corrosion, or chemical exposure (). For wall installation, use cantilever brackets or wall arms. Drill holes at marked support points and insert suitable anchors (e.g., expansion bolts for concrete). Secure the brackets to the wall, ensuring they are level and capable of supporting the tray load (). Support Spacing and Load Maintain proper support intervals, typically every 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and cable weight. Maximum load per hanger usually ranges from 318 kg to 340 kg (700–750 lbs) (). Ensure the tray is level to prevent sagging and allow smooth cable pulling. Installation Steps Attach brackets to the wall at marked points. Mount the tray onto the brackets, using couplers or splice plates to join sections. Level and secure the tray with nuts and washers. Install bends or tees as needed, ensuring smooth transitions for cables. Grounding: Metallic trays must be bonded according to NEC Article 392 to serve as equipment grounding conductors (). Compliance and Safety Maintain clearances for maintenance access (minimum 12 inches above the tray for vertical clearance) (). Do not install trays in hoistways or enclosed spaces.
