

Installing supports for cable trays

Proper installation of cable tray supports involves selecting the right support type, spacing them according to load and tray type, and securely mounting them to structural elements. Typical maximum spans for center-hung supports are around 3.6 meters (12 feet), with a maximum load per hanger ranging from 318 kg to 340 kg (700–750 lbs). Ladder trays often allow slightly longer spans due to their rung structure, while solid-bottom trays may need closer spacing to prevent cable sag. Mounting Supports Supports should be mechanically fastened to structural elements such as ceilings, walls, floors, or steel beams. Use appropriate mounting hardware like anchors, bolts, or threaded rods rated for the expected load. Wall brackets are typically bolted directly to walls, while suspended supports use threaded rods or straps to hang trays from ceilings. Ensure supports are level and aligned to maintain tray stability and proper cable routing. Additional Considerations Load and safety: Always calculate the total cable weight and ensure supports can handle short-circuit forces and environmental loads like wind or snow. Material selection: Steel or stainless steel is common, with galvanization or corrosion-resistant coatings for harsh environments. FRP (fiberglass-reinforced plastic) may be used in corrosive or wet areas. Bonding and grounding: Ensure all supports and trays are properly bonded to maintain electrical safety. Future maintenance: Install supports to allow easy acces...
