Omitting the tertiary (three-level) distribution box is generally not recommended, as it compromises safety, protection, and compliance with hierarchical distribution principles.

Role of the Three-Level Distribution Box

The tertiary distribution box, also called the final distribution box, serves as the last connection point for individual electrical appliances or equipment. It ensures that each device has its own residual current device (RCD) or circuit breaker, following the principle of “one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock” . This setup provides localized protection against electrical faults, leakage currents, and overloads, minimizing the risk of hazards.

Safety and Compliance Considerations

Three-level distribution systems are designed according to hierarchical and branch circuit principles, where no equipment should bypass the intermediate levels . Directly connecting appliances to the main or secondary distribution boxes would violate these principles, potentially leading to:

- Reduced protection against electrical faults and leakage currents
- Increased risk of overloading circuits
- Non-compliance with electrical codes and construction safety standards

The tertiary box also allows for shorter distribution distances, which improves efficiency and reduces voltage drops, as the horizontal distance between the switch box and controlled equipment should ideally not exceed 3 meters .

Omission Might Be Considered

In very small-scale or low-power installations, some designers may consider simplifying the system. However, even in these cases, adequate protection must be maintained, typically by installing RCDs or circuit breakers at the secondary distribution level. This approach is only feasible if:

- The total load is low and predictable
- All appliances can be individually protected without a tertiary box
- Local electrical codes explicitly allow such simplifications
