Connection and Termination Inside the distribution box, cables are typically connected to screw terminals, busbars, or modular connectors. The incoming cable gauge must match or exceed the gauge of outgoing cables to maintain safe current flow. If the distribution box connects to another unit, an external fuse is recommended before the box to provide additional protection. Cable Requirements and Safety Maximum cable cross-section: Often limited to 10 mm² for standard connections. Strain relief: Ensures cables are not stressed or pulled, preventing damage to insulation or terminals. Proper insulation and grounding: Essential for safety and compliance with electrical codes. Inspection and maintenance: Residential boxes should be visually inspected every 3-6 months, with comprehensive checks every 1-2 years; commercial or industrial boxes require more frequent inspections.
