Network Environment: Fiber is immune to electromagnetic interference (EMI) and is suitable for electrically noisy environments, inter-building links, or areas with lightning risk. Copper Ethernet is more susceptible to interference but works well in standard office or home LANs.

Cost and Installation: Ethernet cables are cheaper, easier to install, and support Power over Ethernet (PoE) for devices like IP cameras, Wi-Fi access points, and VoIP phones. Fiber requires transceivers and specialized connectors (LC, SC, ST, MTP/MPO), making it more expensive and complex to deploy.

Switch Port Types: RJ45 ports use copper Ethernet cables and are standard for most home and small office networks. SFP ports are modular and can accept fiber optic or direct attach c...
