The connector includes guide pins for alignment, fiber array slots, spring-loaded mechanisms for stable contact, and housing locks to prevent accidental disconnection. These features ensure low insertion loss and reliable multi-lane optical transmission. Applications MPO patch cords are primarily used for: High-density interconnects in data centers, connecting MPO cassettes, panels, and active equipment. Parallel optical transmission, supporting high-bandwidth applications like AI clusters and GPU-intensive workloads. Rapid deployment in structured cabling systems, reducing installation time and space requirements.
